JOB SUMMARY

UROC was established in 2009, and is a society managed by a Board of Directors. The club currently maintains 54km of trail in the Crowsnest Pass, and actively works to plan and manage mountain bike trails in the area. We're looking for two new people to join our trail crew to continue building and maintaining trails this summer.

As a Trail Crew Member, you will get the chance to work on all the mountain bike trails maintained by UROC in the Crowsnest Pass. Trail Crew Members will work under the direction of UROC's Trail Manager and / or Trail Crew Leader to complete trail building tasks. If you love riding the trails here, this is your chance to spend the summer outside making them even better!

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Complete regular trail maintenance tasks and new trail building projects
- Maintain and repair tools as needed
- Work collaboratively with volunteers
- Assist with trail inspections and planning projects
- Install and maintain signage

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS AND ABILITIES

- Must be able to work in a physically demanding outdoor environment in all weather conditions
- Capable of hiking up to 10km a day carrying a heavy backpack, tools and materials
- Strong teamwork and interpersonal skills
- Ability to learn new skills and follow direction
- Capable of working on tasks independently
- Driver's license

- First aid certification
- Chainsaw certification and experience
- Previous trail building/maintenance experience
- Basic carpentry skills
